SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Senator Warner. I just wanted to emphasize the significance of the six million dollars that would be a part of the LB 309 task force continuation budget. That money would be used for renovation and deferred maintenance for energy conservation and other efforts and as far as I am concerned in the whole capital construction budget there isn't a dollar better spent than the dollars on that program. I have seen the effects of this program in other state facilities. I have seen the effects of energy conservation efforts and state facilities and I just really believe that that is an excellent program and I commend the committee for continuing it and see that it is adequately funded and I encourage its development in the future. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Haberman, did you have a question of Senator Warner?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Yes, I do, Mr. President. Senator Warner, on page 61 of this blue book which is the summary, this book here, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: 61?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Red, on page 61.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: It says that the College of Business Administration structural workload improvement that you are adding \$75,000, what does that mean?

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Haberman, that pertains to LB 999 and it has already been advanced, but that \$75,000 was.... does reflect additional students enrolled in the College of Business Administration and this is staff and related cost in order to provide appropriate class sizes for the number of students that they have enrolled. It is one of the growing areas. In fact the UNO campus was expanded, some of the state college campuses programs were expanded, UNL's business administration was expanded. It is an area that reflects growth in all of the institutions of higher education.
