PRESIDENT: All right, the amendment is withdrawn. What is the next amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kremer had an amendment but I understand he wants to withdraw.

PRESIDENT: So Senator Kremer's amendment is also withdrawn. Next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch moves to amend.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch is not present.

CLERK: There is Senator Koch.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Koch here?

CLERK: Yes, he just walked in.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Senator Koch, we are on LB 1002 and it is your amendment on 1002. The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.
