

that give the contents of the bills both 691 and 882 and some comparison sheets also. We would hope that you would use these and make use of them for your decision making. Again I renew my motion, Mr. President, to adopt the committee amendments. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The first motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to 691. Do I assume that the lights that are on mean that you don't want to talk to the committee amendments but you want to talk to the bill? Is that right, Senator Lamb? Senator Kahle? Senator Newell? Okay, we are just adopting the committee amendments. You don't want to speak to that motion? All right, the motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to 691. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 691. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried the committee amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Lamb, do you wish to speak to the bill?

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I rise to oppose LB 691 and I think that I will do it very briefly and I think that a lot of you have these charts which the Revenue Committee prepared in regard to the distribution of the money under the provisions of LB 882 also under the provisions of LB 691. If you would just ~~like~~ to turn to page seven I will just point out why I am completely opposed to this bill. I happen to represent and live in Custer County. Under the provisions of LB 882 you will note Custer County and also under the present provisions of LB 518 Custer County receives 1.1, slightly over 1.3 million dollars. If you follow across you will see in 1985 under the provisions of 691 that will decrease to \$846,000. That is completely unacceptable. It is robbery in other words, Senator Johnson. Now if you will drop down on that same page you will see what it does to Douglas County under the provisions of LB 882 and 518, Douglas County receives \$11,731,000. But if LB 691 were adopted Douglas County increases to \$17,350,000. That is exactly what we are talking about and I submit that this is inequitable, unfair, I oppose the bill.
