SPEAKER MARVEL: The question is shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 4 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All Legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Encourage unauthorized personnel to leave. Senator Powers, Senator Warner, Senator Cope, Senator Schmit, Senator Maresh, Senator Kahle, Senator Sieck, Senator Kremer, Senator Merz, Senator DeCamp, Senator Lewis, Senator Chambers. Senator Sieck, Senator Chambers, there's Senator Sieck. Senator Chambers and Senator Lewis. Senator Newell, everybody is here but Senator Chambers.

SENATOR NEWELL: If we could have a roll call I think that would help.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Call the roll. We are voting on the Newell amendment to LB 882. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 19 ayes, 23 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 4 present and not voting. Vote appears on page 1542 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is by Senator Lewis.
