

SPEAKER MARVEL: Four.

SENATOR DWORAK: I request a Call of the House please and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators should be in their seats and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel. The Legislature is under Call. Senator Keyes, do you want to record your presence please. Senator Murphy, do you want to record your presence. Senator Powers, Senator Cope, Senator Lewis, Senator Chambers. The House is under Call. All legislators please return to your seats. Who asked for the roll call vote? Senator Dworak, everybody is here except Senator Chambers, do you want to proceed with the roll call?

SENATOR DWORAK: Is Senator Chambers. . . is it possible to locate Senator Chambers, Mr. Speaker, if there is a possibility I really need the vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Talk to the man in the red coat. Right there.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers is out of the building. His office is still open, his secretary is there. But, I'll go ahead. Proceed with the roll please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 21 ayes, 22 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, 1 absent and not voting. Vote appears on page 1545 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. What is the next motion?
