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ninety-three counties, any counties which do not express an affirmative on it, those counties should be eliminated from whatever bill is being before the Legislature related to counties?

SENATOR MURPHY: No, I would rather say, Senator Chambers, as I am saying here that when people from my district express an objection to something that they have not asked for, then I am I think to a degree beholding to represent that interest. The day those people come to me and say we want to, I will be happy to endorse it but they have come to me and expressly said we do not want to.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is this group opposed to women's rights or the ERA and related matters, the group you talked to?

SENATOR MURPHY: I would assume that they are, Senator Chambers, but I do not wish to speak with that kind of authority. I have gone to none of the meetings.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. I am opposed to Senator Murphy's amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes and then Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR KEYES: Well, Senator Murphy, I will make it very short. I want Sarpy County to be included in this. If there is any time that the women in Sarpy County want to set up this organization, I want them to have the opportunity to do so and so if you will bring your amendment down to 50,000, then maybe the Legislature will vote it in. Otherwise I am going to support the bill as it is presently written.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I would like Senator Murphy to make the same expression. I know that there is considerable support for this bill in Douglas County. There is considerable support among the members of the Douglas County delegation here in the Legislature for including Douglas County in this bill. I think it is important for Douglas County to have the option of setting up the Commission on the Status of Women if they want, and as long as Douglas County is being excluded from the bill as it is with your amendment, I cannot support your amendment.
