LB 882

SPEAKER MARVEL: While we are waiting I will introduce in the north balcony from Senator Lamb's District eight FFA members from Ainsworth, Nebraska. Will you stand so we can see you and say, good afternoon. Over here.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Labeledz moves to suspend Rule 6, Section 3, Rule 7, Section 3 and vote on the advancement of LB 882 without further amendment or debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. As I said this morning, my motion was up there since yesterday about three or four o'clock after the amendments were pouring in on 882. I discussed it with the sponsors of the bill and they asked me to go with the motion because of the fact that so much time has been spent on this bill. If there are additional amendments, I am sure they can be put on on Select File. I feel that LB 882 on General File we have had enough time spent on it and Senator Schmit and Senator Kahle will go on with the discussion as to why we should suspend the rules and vote LB 882 advancement rather than spend all afternoon on it. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to suspend the rules for the purpose of advancing LB 882 to E & R for Review. Is that right, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Senator Hefner, do you wish to speak to the motion?

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I support the amendment that Senator Labeledz has put up on the desk. I think we have debated this issue long enough. We debated 691 yesterday and then we went on to 882 and I think we are ready to either vote this up or down. So therefore I would urge you to support this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Let's cease debate, please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. Shall debate cease? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.
