CLERK: Senator Kelly voting aye. 26 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Can I read some things?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, and then we will go to LB 608.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined LB 765 and find the same correctly enrolled; 423, 592, 686, 696, 780, 863, 863A, 892, 912, 986 and 741, all correctly enrolled.
