LB 608, 882, 905

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to expedite. Senator Schmit, your light is on. Did you wish to be recognized again? Okay, the motion is to expedite 882. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The motion before the House is to expedite 882. Have you all voted? Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the first motion is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators return to your seats, record your presence. There are officially four absent....five absent, and the Clerk is authorized to accept call-in votes. Meanwhile, let's see, Senator Koch, Senator George, Senator Cope, Senator Keyes, Senator Schmit, Senator Beutler, Senator Maresh, Senator DeCamp. Whoever is whistling is off-key. Okay, do you want to call the roll. Do we have everybody here? Is anybody missing? Is everybody here? Senator Lewis and Senator George are absent. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Ask for a roll call vote, please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, roll call vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on pages 1586 and 1587 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Are we ready to go to 608?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, what do we have on LB 608?

CLERK: Mr. President, first of all I have got an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Chambers on 905. (See pages 1587 and 1588 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, LB 608 was introduced by the Revenue Committee. (Read title to LB 608.) The bill was originally read on January 9, referred to Revenue. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments
