SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I am fully aware of our time schedule, I really am, and if I didn't think this was a pretty important amendment I wouldn't do this, but I think few of us are failing to recognize what we are doing here today and if we want to do something constructive for Nebraska...I know this is a piece before a motion, I am going to move for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: I am allowing it, so you are asking for a Call of the House. All right, a Call of the House has been requested. The motion is, shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will see that all members return to the chamber and all members will return to their desks and record your presence. The House is under Call. All other people, all other personnel will leave the floor of the Legislature. Still two excused and that is it. Only two excused. Would Irene Wesely please stand? Mrs. Wesely, welcome and she has prepared some kolaces and if that doesn't bring all the members back in I don't know what will. Thanks, Mrs. Wesely. Senator Kremer, do you want to take some call in votes at this time while they are...?

SENATOR KREMER: Take in some call in votes.

PRESIDENT: All right, we will do that. We will accept call in votes at this time.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye, Senator Wagner voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch, will you put your light on? Thank you. Senator Chambers, there you are. Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Lewis. I guess Senator Labeledz, Senator Lewis, Senator DeCamp and Senator Vickers is here. Senator Vickers, would you show us your presence? Thank you. They are not in their seats, that is true. Would all the members please get to your desks and register your
