PRESIDENT: We still have four members to bring in,  
Senator Kremer. Senator Venditte is here. Senator  
Venditte, do you want to show your presence?

CLERK: Senator Venditte voting aye, Senator Beutler  
voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, Senator Labeledz and Senator  
DeCamp are the ones that are not present. Would all  
members please remain at your desks so we can see who is  
here and who isn't. I think that we have got it pegged  
at Senator Lewis, Senator Labeledz and Senator DeCamp.  
Sergeant at Arms, has someone gone over to the Governor's  
office? Thank you. I understand there is some visiting  
at the Governor's office. All right, here is Senator  
DeCamp.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp voting aye. Senator Koch voting aye.

PRESIDENT: All right, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption  
of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The Kremer amendment is  
adopted and I believe that takes care of all the amend-  
ments. Does it not, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, it does.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Warner, we are ready to  
advance LB 1004.

SENATOR WARNER: Move the bill be advanced, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Seeing none, the  
question is the advance of LB 1004. All those in favor  
vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to  
advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and LB 1004 is advanced to E & R  
initial.
