CLERK: Real quick, Mr. President, one brief item. Senator Haberman would like to print amendments to LB 899 in the Legislative Journal. (See page 1601 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Before we begin the discussion on 993, it is my privilege to introduce to you from the leading legislative district in the state, 4 members of the League of Women Voters from Hastings, Nebraska, underneath the South balcony, Wauneta Nitzel, Raoma Beavers, Thortus Kleager, Marjorie Hayes with Mrs. Marvel. Will you ladies stand so we may recognize you. Now that we have finished extended debate we are ready for LB 993.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 993 was introduced by the Business and Labor Committee and signed by the membership. (Read.) The bill was first read on March 3 of this year. It was referred to the Business and Labor Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending by the Business and Labor Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Maresch.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, the committee amendments include on page 6, strike beginning with "claim" in line 13 through \$38,583.88, in line 16 after line 21 insert "claim No. 048, against Wayne State College, pay to Fox-Stanley Photo Producers, Inc., 7204 Jones, Omaha, Nebraska, 68114, out of the general fund, \$650.00." And number two amendment is "on page 11, line 3 strike "Watson" and insert "Watkins"; and in line 7 strike "Dain" and insert "Bain", and number three "on page 20 after line 2 insert "Claim No. 261, against the Game and Parks Commission, pay to Harry Babcock, Sr., Long Pine, Nebraska, 79217, out of the General Fund \$83.56." Mr. Speaker, I move that the committee amendments be adopted.
