SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is advancement of LB 993 to E & R for review. All those in favor... Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, this will be very brief but I want it in the record. Since Senator Kelly was not in a position to attach his Soukup amendment I am not going to be able to vote for this bill and I want it clear as to why I am voting in the negative at this time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.
