SENATOR WARNER: No. I will be glad to sit down and visit with you, Senator Schmit, and show you how that would not work.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well I would rather find out a way that we could make it work, Senator. I know that you have been around long enough to make about anything work that you want to make work and I would suggest that I still am going to go along with 722 based on the premise that we will work out some kind of a division of that revenue, whether we bring it out of 361 or however we get it. I don't think that dollar is going to be stamped 361 or 722 when it gets back to the city and county but I do think we need to recognize that they have a need also and so I will vote to advance 722 and work with you to try to rearrange the funding so that we have some kind of equitable solution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Venditte.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been...there are no other lights on so we can proceed, Pat. Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Warner amendment to the committee amendments. Is there any other discussion on that? Senator Warner, do you wish to advance? Okay the motion is to adopt the Warner amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 2 nays on adoption of the Warner amendment to the committee amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. The committee amendments need to be adopted to 722. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. No, this is the adoption of the committee amendments as amended. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments as amended, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The committee amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Warner, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: No.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me.

SENATOR WARNER: I have an amendment pending, Mr. President.
