SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler, sustained. The floor has...let's see, we have six lights on. I would like to find out who wants to speak to the Warner amendment. Senator Hefner, do you wish to speak to the Warner amendment? Senator Schmit has spoken. Senator Koch, do you wish to speak to the Warner amendment? Senator Newell, do you wish to speak to the Warner amendment? Your light is on. I am calling those who have their lights on. Senator Frank Lewis, do you wish to speak to the...? Okay, Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: In keeping with Beutler's rules I move the previous question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do I see five hands? Okay, all those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is cease debate, shall debate cease. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner. The motion is the Warner amendment to the bill. All those in favor of the Warner amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President. Mr. President, I have an amendment by Senator Fowler found on page 1358 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: Mr. President, this amendment that establishes a system of priorities for use of road funds. I understand that if this bill advances to Select File there will be efforts to try to negotiate some type of bill. I am sure that this amendment will be part of those negotiations. I am sure that everybody is interested in seeing it included so I will just withdraw it on General File, knowing that it will be added on Select.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Hearing no objections, so ordered. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is your light...? Okay, go ahead, Senator Maresh. The Chair has difficulty determining whether you wish to speak or not because some of you leave your lights on. It is almost impossible to determine your intention. So we would appreciate it when you get through talking if you would turn your light off.
