SENATOR KEYES: No, except Senator Kelly is lightly wrong. The Game and Parks Commission have no right to improve any road beyond the boundaries of their parks.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question then is the adoption of the Keyes-Hoagland amendment to LB 873. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion carries. The amendment is adopted. Senator Keyes, do you wish to return it? The motion is to return LB 873 to E & R for Engrossment. Any discussion? All those in favor of the return of LB 873 to E & R for Engrossment signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. LB 873 is advanced to E & R for Engrossment. Before we get into the next matter, the Chair would like to recognize as guests of Senator Lewis from Senator Lewis' District at Bellevue 25 adults from the Welcome Wagon Group, all ladies from Bellevue, Mrs. June Ethridge, the leader. They are up here in the north balcony. Would the ladies from Bellevue stand and be recognized. Welcome to the Welcome Wagon. Now, Mr. Clerk, I believe we are ready for the next bill. If all the members would please return to your desks, we are back on Final Reading. We are ready for LB 689 on Final Reading. We will wait until we get all the members back at their desks. So would all the members please return to your desks for the purposes of continuing and finally finishing, perhaps, Final Reading today. All right, Mr. Clerk, I guess we are sufficiently ready to...we will continue now on Final Reading by reading LB 689 on Final Reading, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 689 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 689 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1622 and 1623 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 2 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.
