be required for April through June of this year for a total of \$24,683. Of course, that lease would not be... would be subject to appropriation by the Legislature, but the committee feels that that is appropriate to recognize that lease and it's a legitimate lease because I am sure they got it at a more economical rate per square foot by recognizing those two additions. The second amendment would add \$10,000 to the current year's appropriations for the Crime Victim's Reparation Board. Received a letter that the Clerk just indicated as having received from Brent Stevenson I assume was the same letter, which we received a copy of this morning. Currently, we appropriated last year \$10,000 for the Crime Victim's Reparation Board for reimbursement to any victims. The letter indicates that based upon the approval of reparations that the committee has so far approved they're \$2987.48 short, but we are suggesting since there is three months left in the year and to have adequate funds to cover the 2900 plus dollars plus some revenue for these last three months that the appropriation for the balance of this current fiscal year be increased by additional 10,000 or a total of \$20,000 for the current year. I would move that the bill be returned for these specific amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion, first of all, is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 995. All those in....
