SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is return the bill for the Labeledz amendment. All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Labeledz amendment. Have you all voted? Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Hate to do it, but I guess we will have to have a Call of the House.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Call of the House is requested. Shall the House go under Call? Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators return to your seats. Record your presence. Unauthorized personnel leave the floor. There are one, two, three absent. Senator Schmit, Senator Fowler, Senator Kahle, Senator Hefner, Senator Sieck, Senator Dworak, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Wagner, Senator Newell, Senator Lewis, Senator Kelly, Senator Labeledz. Seven missing. The Clerk is authorized to take call-in votes. Have you all recorded your presence?

CLERK: Senator George voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You're looking for Senator Schmit, Senator Kahle, Senator Sieck, Senator Dworak, Senator Fitzgerald, Senator Lewis. Senator Sieck, Senator Lewis, Senator Fitzgerald, will you please record your presence? We spend about a fourth of our time on Final Reading and about a fourth of our time trying to get people into their seats. That leaves fifty percent. Senator Sieck, would you record your presence, please? Senator Labeledz, we have got everybody here now. Do you want to go on with the roll call? Okay, proceed. Roll call vote.
