SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the bill is returned. Are we ready to vote the bill? Okay, Senator Koch, do you move the adoption of the amendment?

SENATOR KOCH: I so move, Mr. Speaker. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the adoption of the Koch amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The motion is on the Koch amendment. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Koch amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Shall we move the bill back? The motion now, Senator Koch, is to rerefer the bill. All in favor of that motion vote aye. Say aye, I guess...say no. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is readvanced. The next one, LB 507.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman is excused, but I understood he wanted to withdraw them, so...withdraw his motions.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, if there is no objection, so ordered. The next one is 847.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 847. Senator Kelly moves to return the bill for a specific amendment. He wishes, first of all, Mr. President, Senator Kelly has amendments on 1176 that he wants to withdraw. He has some on 1188 that he wishes to withdraw. Is that right, Senator? Okay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What are there, two amendments to be withdrawn?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Hearing no objection, so ordered.
