LB 877, 789

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp moves to return LB 877 to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment changes the effective date from August 1 until December 31, 1980.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I move the adoption. He explained it. It just corrects a date.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to return the bill to Select File for a specific amendment. The specific amendment has been explained. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The amendment is...let's see, the bill is returned. Now you move the adoption of the amendment, right? All those in favor of the adoption of the amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Now the motion is to readvance the bill to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. 877 is readvanced. The next bill is LB 789, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner has amendments on 1234 that he wishes to withdraw. Is that true, Senator? Okay. Senator Warner now moves to return the bill, Mr. President, for a specific amendment. (Read the Warner amendment as found on page 1644 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: All right. Mr. President, the amendments I withdraw were drafted to the bill on General File and the amendments now are drafted to the bill on Final Reading. That was the only difference. The purpose of the amendment, and I'm not going to spend much time but just briefly give you my rationale for it. It reduces the dollar amount that is in the standard need for ADC from the bill's requirement of \$293 to \$270 for one adult and child and reduces the individual from the bill's \$71 to \$65 per each additional
