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then in the very next paragraph we set up a county surveyor's job to do the work that is presently being done in that particular position, or in other words, we are going to set up a county engineer and then we are going to hire...have him hire a registered county surveyor to do the work. I would ask you to take a good hard look at the bill itself, but at least Senator Stoney's amendment is a move in the right direction. When you talk about the cost of government and why it gets there, take a good look at this particular bill. You are creating an engineering office and then you are going to let him hire somebody to do his work. That is how the cost of government goes up. I would strongly urge you to support Senator Stoney. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Reutzel. Senator Reutzel. The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Yes. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate is ceased. Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Members of the Legislature, I will be brief in the closing. Again, I just bring this to your attention and hope that we are prudent in enacting this law and making it definitive enough so that the individual that will deal with these major decisions concerning construction of streets, bridges, culverts, etcetera, will have the proper qualifications. I guess a good analogy would be in the medical profession, if I needed a thoracic surgeon to perform pulmonary surgery, I certainly wouldn't go to an internist or I wouldn't go to an orthopedic to perform that particular surgery. So I am not looking at the individual that presently holds that position or those that might subsequently hold the position, but only from the standpoint of the taxpayers and that the individual that has this job and has the responsibility of these projects in expending their dollars is qualified for the responsibilities that they may have. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the return to the Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 10 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

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
