SENATOR MURPHY: I don't know if you are going from the script, go to the amendment, Senator.

SENATOR JOHNSON: I am working on the amendment which is Request 2270, the white copy.....

SENATOR MURPHY: That's it, thank you.

SENATOR JOHNSON: All right, and I am on page 1.

SENATOR MURPHY: All right.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes, sir.

SENATOR MURPHY: Right.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Do I want the filing to be in the Public Service Commission?

SENATOR MURPHY: Yes.

SENATOR JOHNSON: It says the proper place to file an order to perfect a security interest as follows: For, A, when the collateral is on harvested crops then in the office of the County Clerk in the county where the land on which the crops are growing or ought to be planted and growing is located, and in the office of the Public Service Commission where a duplicate copy shall be filed and indexed as a crop lien. Now you asked me if that is a correct place. If you would give me a couple of minutes I will quick-like turn to my volume of 9-401 and see if that is exactly what the present language is.

SENATOR MURPHY: Well, before you do that, why don't you look at page 9 of your amendment, subsection 1, which repeats your...or to me seems to be a subsection of the same section, which says verbatim what you just said only it says file it in the office of the Secretary of State.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Right.

SENATOR MURPHY: You had help with this bill, Senator, and you need a lot more. So far we file it with the Public Service Commission and the Secretary of State all in your amendment.

SENATOR JOHNSON: No, we file with the Public Service Commission until 1981 at which time the provisions...the full
