CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate ceases. The Chair recognizes Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I would ask the body to support the motion to bring the bill back from Final Reading for purposes of then taking it back to Select File to attach the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is on the reconsideration of 741. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion now is to return the bill to Select File for the specific amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the bill is returned. Okay, now the motion is to adopt the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the readvancement of the bill to E & R for Engrossment say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is readvanced. I have no more voice, so there is nothing else we can do.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Venditte moves to adjourn until April 2 at 9:00 a.m.
