SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, there is only part of the bill left. That is Senator Sieck's bill, LB 643, and I would suppose, Mr. Clerk or Mr. Speaker, I am not sure exactly what the status of the bill is.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR KREMER: The committee amendments amended Senator Sieck's bill, 643, quite extensively. I am not sure we have got a bill at all. LB 830 did not come out as a bill and neither did LB 984.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, we have the bill as originally drafted, is that the condition of the bill?

SENATOR KREMER: My opinion would be we have got the bill as originally drafted without amendments.

CLERK: Right.

SENATOR KREMER: So that would be Senator Sieck's bill and I would yield to Senator Sieck.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Sieck, do you want to move advancement of the bill?

SENATOR SIECK: I move that we advance the bill but I would like to make an amendment on the bill to delete Section 5 because there was considerable opposition to Section 5 and I feel this would be proper to the body to do this. So I would request that this be done. But the balance of the bill I surely can support. It is a good bill and will correct a lot of problems.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You will have to bring an amendment up to the desk.

SENATOR SIECK: I will do this on Select File. I think that would be proper. I will advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the advancement of 643 to E & R for review. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I think we ought to have a little explanation of the bill as it now stands. Would you care to do that, Senator Sieck?
