SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Senator Murphy, are you ready to record the vote?

SENATOR MURPHY: If we wait ten minutes will it improve? If not, record the vote.

SPEAKER MARVEL: What was your question, whether we wait ten minutes you would improve? Oh. Record the vote.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Is there any other motions, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Senator Dworak has amendments but I understand he wants to withdraw. Okay, that is all I have on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, I move for the advancement of LB 824 as amended to E & R initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor of that motion ...Senator Cullan, your light is on. Do you wish to speak? Okay, all in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1659 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Is there anything else to read into the record before we recess?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator Haberman would like to print amendments to LB 739, Senator George to 865. (See pages 1659-60 of the Journal.) New A bill, 608A by the Revenue Committee. (Read same as found on page 1661.)
