SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats, record your presence and the Clerk is authorized to take call in votes. We are voting to advance the bill, 608, to E & R for review.

CLERK: Senator Warner, you had voted no, Senator. Senator Simon voting aye, Senator Haberman voting no, Senator Schmit voting no, Senator Wesely voting aye, Senator Pirsch voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Fitzgerald voting no, Senator Koch voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance the bill.

CLERK: You had voted no, Senator.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Senator Koch, will you record your presence. Senator Merz, he is excused. Senator Dworak, Senator Goodrich, Senator Lewis, Senator Cullan, Senator Cullan is excused. Senator Koch, would you record your presence please? Call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on pages 1662-63 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.
