SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the Keyes amendment. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: A question of Senator Keyes so I would understand precisely what his amendment was.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes closed. I am sorry.

SENATOR JOHNSON: I understood he closed. He said repeal LB 1 and LB 2. LB 1 was repealed by 285. Do you want to repeal LB 285 as well, Senator?

SENATOR KEYES: The 285 comes in there and also repeal the lid that was put on the Omaha and the Nebraska City School Board.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Keyes amendment. Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, a point of clarification. Would you have the Clerk read the amendment of Senator Keyes, please?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have the amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Well, I think I do, Senator. Senator Keyes amendment would read to repeal the provisions of LB 1, and did you want LB 285 inserted in there, Senator? You did. LB 1, LB 285 passed in the '79 session and LB 2 from the '78 Special session and any limitation placed on a budget pursuant to LB 2.

SENATOR KEYES: Just to say this. I had the sections of the law all written out in someplace. I don't find it in my desk right now. I thought I had it on 628 but it don't seem to be up there either.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, all those in favor of the Keyes amendment to LB 609 vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the adoption of the Keyes
