LB 609, 939

Okay, call the roll. The roll is on the adoption of the Johnson amendment to LB 609.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 1671 of the 19 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor of 609 being advanced to E & R for review vote aye, opposed vote no. Senator Carsten, this is your bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: How many are absent? Okay, let's have a Call of the House and a roll call vote. Let's get it over with.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Everybody check in and then we will proceed. Record your presence, please. Senator Warner. Senator Sieck, will you record your presence. Senator Sieck and Senator Kelly, will you both record your presence. Senator Carsten, everybody is accounted for except Senator Lewis. Do you want to proceed with the roll call vote? Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on pages 1671 and 1672 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Legislature is under Call and also under some other items that I won't bring up that I won't bring up right now.

CLERK: (Continued to read roll call vote.) 21 ayes, 20 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. We would like to take up LB 939 since LB 820 has some amendments pending. Let's see if we can get the items off of Select File and then as far as I am concerned, we can adjourn. We will try 939 and there are several amendments and if we get piled up we will just have to pass over it.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 939 was introduced by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee and signed by the members. (Read.) The bill was read on January 23, referred to Miscellaneous Subjects. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by Senator Newell's Miscellaneous Subjects Committee.
