the west door of the Capitol upon recess this noon. That is on the west side of the Capitol, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, we are ready then for agenda item #5, Final Reading. The Sergeant at Arms will secure the aisles, see that all members are at their desks, and when everybody is at their desk, we will start Final Reading. We have got a long session of Final Reading so if everybody would get to their desks, we can start. The sooner we start the better. Is everybody ready for Final Reading? If we could break up all these conversations, you are going to have time to do it later. We had better get started. What is it? Three hours of reading or something like that, and if Senator Reutzel wants it read particularly slow, it might be six. It may be the fifty-fifth day but we are driving slow, I will tell you. Okay, Mr. Clerk, I guess we will begin then with the Final Reading of LB 768.

CLERK: Final Reading of LB 768.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 768 pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1692, Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 768 passes with the emergency clause attached. I believe the next one, we have to suspend the rules.

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, in order to read LB 995, we need to suspend Rule 6, Section 7 to read the bill today.

PRESIDENT: Speaker Marvel, do you move to suspend the rules? All right. The motion is made by the Speaker to suspend the rules to take up LB 995 on Final Reading. Any discussion? If not, the question is, shall the rules be suspended to take up LB 995 on Final Reading this morning. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays on the rules suspension, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The rules are suspended and we may take up LB 995 at this time. The Clerk will now read on Final
