LB 939, 939A

I would ask unanimous consent that the bill be passed over or that at least those two amendments be held for Select File because there aren't enough people here now. Like I say, I don't mind impossible things but the really difficult ones I would just as soon pass, but until there are more members here it is impossible, Mr. President, and I would ask that those amendments be withdrawn. I will offer them on Select.

SENATOR CLARK: They are withdrawn. What is the next amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, the only other amendments are the Lamb-Schmit amendments and they are both excused until they arrive. So I have nothing further on the bill at this time.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Lewis. The motion before the House is the advancement of the bill. Is there any discussion on that? It has been moved by Senator Sieck that we advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted on the advancement of the bill? We are voting on the advancement of 939 to Select File. Record the vote. A record vote has been asked for.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1715 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Warner wanted to vote.

SENATOR WARNER: Voting no.

CLERK: Senator Warner voting no.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is advanced. LB 820. Is there an A bill on 939?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CLARK: All right, go ahead.

CLERK: (Read LB 939A.) The bill was introduced on February 26. It was referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Does anyone want to have any discussion on this A bill? Senator Sieck. It has been moved advancement
