Secondly, there was strong testimony at the time the bill was considered before the committee and the committee took into consideration the testimony offered and the reasons given, also the recommendation made by the Appropriations Committee that first considered the sunset provision of the dealer licensing board and for that reason the committee came out with the recommendation you have before you in the way of committee amendments.
