SENATOR DWORAK: But then I want to know exactly whether we are suspending the rules as per your instructions, as per your explanation that there will be a vote up or down and the only thing we are doing is suspending the rules for that procedure or something was handed out on the floor that automatically incorporates a lot of amendments that I am particularly not sure I can support, so it makes a difference who makes the motion and what form that motion is made and I think we all better be very careful on this and watch this very closely.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All I am talking about, Senator Dworak, if I...I want to be sure we are talking on the same wave length now and all I am talking about on a suspension of the rules is a suggested solution to the bills on General File this afternoon and that would simply mean that you would vote that bill up or down.

SENATOR DWORAK: And that motion has not been made?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you talking about the individual motion on bills?

SENATOR DWORAK: Right.

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, that hasn't been made.

SENATOR DWORAK: Has the motion been made to suspend the rules as per the fifteen minute limitation and then an up or down vote?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, no, not yet, because we haven't started on that category yet.

SENATOR DWORAK: And then one other question, Mr. Speaker, when you refer to General File, specifically what are you referring to?

SPEAKER MARVEL: At the moment I am referring to the agenda that was passed out to you before lunch.

SENATOR DWORAK: And then we would be precluded from any other bills on General File?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Not as far as I am concerned but we have to go through the list first.

SENATOR DWORAK: And we are going fifteen minutes and then we would go right into General File as to the order of that General File list?
