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make a couple concluding sentences?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: In that tire advertisement Mr. Hoberman gets on television and he says, "I will undersell anybody. You bring a tire offer in and I will undersell if by \$5.00." Now what Senator Beutler's amendment does is it says, we are not going to make that illegal in the State of Nebraska because automobile dealers ought to be able to advertise that way. I think we should return to the free enterprise system in this area. Evidently the automobile dealers think that too much free enterprise is not a good thing, but let's adopt the Beutler amendments and get something done that ought to be done.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hefner. Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 4 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler to close on his amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I have no closing, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is this the second Beutler amendment that is 2351? Is that what we are voting on? All those in favor of the second Beutler amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. What is the next amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a third Beutler amendment and this is request #2352, Senator.

SENATOR BUETLER: Mr. Speaker, I would ask unanimous consent to withdraw that amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator, request #2076.

SENATOR BEUTLER: #2352? Is that the one you just read? Isn't it?
