Mr. President, Senator Cullan asks unanimous consent to expedite LB 820 and LB 939.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to move your...

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that these two bills be expedited. The reason to expedite these bills that they are the sunset bills and it would be appropriate to have them on Select File as soon as possible so that we can make sure that they are processed in the time remaining.
