required in that and I think we have argued this question of the one third, one third before. As it is now I could not support advancing it because of that rigid requirement and I do think the Department of Agriculture does have some authority for this program.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any other discussion? Okay, Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Move for the advancement.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the bill to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill, LB 283.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 283 was introduced by the Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee. (Read.) The bill was first read on January 15 of last year. The bill was referred to Retirement. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending by the Retirement Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: I move for the adoption of the amendments. The bill as originally written covered any city with the home rule charter. The amendment limits it only to metropolitan class cities. I believe there is a further amendment that Senator Lewis is going to offer and I think he can explain that and carry the bill from there but this first amendment limits it to Omaha rather than making it all home rule charter cities. I would move for its adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 283. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Goodrich had an amendment I understand he wants to withdraw. Is that true, Senator?
