LB 872, 872A, 647, 899, 1002

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 872A was introduced by Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: ...(mike not turned on immediately)...the bill and I move that it be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of LB 872A, the advancement to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on 872A. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays on advancement of the A bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, real quickly, Senator Simon would like to print amendments to LB 899; Senator DeCamp to 899 and 647. Senator DeCamp would like to print amendments to LB 1002 and Senator Hoagland to LB 647. (See pages 1738-39 of the Journal.) That is all I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we will see that tomorrow we will have some General File and also Select File. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. Chairman, I move we adjourn to nine o'clock tomorrow morning.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried. We are adjourned.
