is over? Lets go on with the next item on the agenda, item number six. I'm sure that the Speaker would like to see his agenda used yet this morning. We will start, Mr. Clerk, then with Select File, agenda item number six, LB 361.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments to 361.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to LB 361.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 361. Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 361 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments on LB 361 are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis now moves to amend the bill. Read Landis amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is a technical amendment. If you appropriate money it has to have somebody receive the money and you have to name the fund to do so. That is what this amendment does. It is purely of technical nature. I would expect by the way, through the course of the morning we will be talking about both 361 and 722. This is just a housekeeping measure and I hope if we take care of this we can get to the substantive policy issue in weighing those two bills against each other.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, the Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: (no response).

PRESIDENT: Senator Fitzgerald.

SENATOR FITZGERALD: Mr. President, members, with your permission could we hold 361 and take 722 up first? Or do I have to have the Speaker's permission?

PRESIDENT: Well I wish that we would follow the Speaker's order. I'm going to rule that any deviation at this point is a change in the Speaker's order unless the Speaker, who is not here at the moment, unless he agrees with it, Senator Fitzgerald.

SENATOR FITZGERALD: I did talk to the Speaker, Senator Warner and I did talk to the Speaker this morning and he is over in the East Chamber and he would agree with this because 722 is a new bill, a new way to get gas tax and we all know how 361 works, 23 1/3, 23 1/3 and 53 1/3. I think it would be fair
