CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to 722.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Wesely for the E & R amendments on LB 722.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to LB 722.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 722. Any discussion? If not, all those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to 722 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk, go ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Fowler has amendments that are found on page 1358 of the Journal.

SENATOR FOWLER: Can we pass over those?

PRESIDENT: Senator Fowler, do you wish to pass over them?

SENATOR FOWLER: Yes.

PRESIDENT: You are withdrawing your amendments at this time. They are withdrawn. Proceed.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh moves to indefinitely postpone the bill. That would lay it over.

PRESIDENT: Okay, that motion. . . .Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would move to, I don't have the right rule, to suspend the rule to take up the kill motion today. As I recall that is the courtesy to the introducer to be prepared, and I am prepared to defend the bill.

PRESIDENT: Yes, it is. Senator Warner moves to suspend the rule to take up the motion to indefinitely postpone today or immediately. Any discussion on that motion? Senator Maresh, do you have anything? All right, the motion then is. . . Senator Kelly, did you wish to speak to it?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, and it is a little bit technical but yesterday we had this same question before us where we suspended the rules without the specific rules being cited and/or written and were fuzzy and it caused us a lot of trouble yesterday and there was a precedent set that when we suspend these rules that we will do it on a written motion and specific rules would be stated.

PRESIDENT: All right, we will wait for that written motion right now then.
