CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1756 and 1757 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Do you have anything to read in before we proceed with....okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 722A. There are no E & R amendments. Senator Warner has an amendment to the bill, however.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Read the amendment.

CLERK: (Read the Warner amendment to LB 722A as found on page 1757 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendments. The first amendment is the necessary language to appropriate the funds for the Landis amendment. The second reduces the...based upon the estimate of receipts from the previous 16 million and because it's only...goes into effect October 1, it reduces that to \$13,982,800. I move the amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the Warner amendment to LB 722A. Have you all voted? Record. Mr. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Now we have to move the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance the bill to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The motion is on the advancement of the bill to E & R for Engrossment. Have you voted? Have you all voted? Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move...ask for a Call of the House.
