LB 361, 643, 940

CLERK: 13 ayes, 3 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would accept call-in votes. Request call-in votes.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Clerk is authorized to take call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Simon voting aye. Senator Cope voting aye. Senator Clark had voted no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The A bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman would like to print amendments to LB 643. (See pages 1757 and 1758 of the Legislative Journal.) And Senator Landis to LB 940. (See page 1758 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we are ready for LB 361.

CLERK: Mr. President, we considered 361 this morning. The E & R amendments were adopted. The Landis amendment was adopted. I now have an amendment from Senator Hefner. The Hefner amendment is to strike the Landis amendment which was adopted on March 31 and is on page 1604 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. Chairman, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any objection? If not, so ordered. Do you want to recognize....

CLERK: Yes, Senator Keyes wishes to amend, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me. Senator Fitzgerald, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR FITZGERALD: This is our bill and I would like to pass over 361 and hold it on Select File because I do not think it is a necessity. We do not need it now with 722.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to lay it over.
