LB 361, 773A, 800

my good friend, Senator Keyes, in his intentions, and fortunately, Senator Keyes, you don't always control the Legislature down here. SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, LB 773A is the appropriation necessary to carry out the legislative intent of 773. It has to do with the coordinating commission and those agencies that work in Special Education and the amount of the A bill is \$32,000, a little more than that. I ask for the advancement of 773A to E & R Final.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor of advancing 773A say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next one is LB 800.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 800. I have no E & R amendments to the bill. Senator Newell has the first amendment. Is Senator Newell in the Chamber?
