CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh moves to amend the bill, page 800...I'm sorry, LB 800, page 23, strike section 6. (See page 1759 of the Journal.)

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Yes, this is to do away with the April 1st date of enactment of this bill. With the emergency clause it will go into effect as soon as the Governor signs the bill. We passed that April 1st which we were trying to get in compliance with and presently that is outdated, so I move that we adopt this amendment to get in compliance as soon as the Governor signs it. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the Maresh amendment. Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: A question of Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Yes.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Now, does this tighten up the bill?

SENATOR MARESH: No, this loosens it up, what Congress is presently doing to not disregard the various pension plans and those that presently are....

SENATOR REUTZEL: Okay, so this is only to adjust our bill to comply with the federal law.

SENATOR MARESH: To conform with the federal law that they are passing now.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the Maresh amendment. All those in favor...Senator Dworak. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Maresh amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment is adopted. Any more amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell now moves to amend, and the Newell amendments are on page 1499 of the Journal.
