SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, these amendments lower the fee charged for the various types of milk, in one instance from 4 to 3 and in another instance from  $3\frac{1}{2}$  to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ , and the department feels that they can get by with these fees. There was some concern and they may have to raise them in the future, but at the present time they are deemed to be adequate. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: I call for the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the question has been called for. Do I see five hands? All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed no. Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate is ceased. Senator Schmit, do you want to close?

SENATOR SCHMIT: No closing, Mr. President. I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of advancing...all in favor of the adoption of the Schmit amendment to 632 say aye. Opposed no. I wish you guys would make up your minds. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Is there anything else on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Schmit, do you wish to advance the bill? All those in favor of advancing 632 to E & R for Engrossment say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. 632A. Senator Schmit.
