That's the motion. Is that right, Senator Newell? Okay, all those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 2 nays on adoption of the Newell, Hoagland, Barrett amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion now is to advance the bill and then we've got two motions to return. So, Senator Newell, do you want to advance the bill? Okay, the motion is to advance the bill to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. Now do we have an amendment to return?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, Senator Lewis moves to return LB 535 to Select File for a specific amendment, and the amendment is to add a new section. (Read the Lewis amendment as found on page 1774 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp, are you taking that amendment? Okay.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I think we haggled and hassled over the previous amendments and this amendment a couple hours the last time it was up and I don't think there was anybody that disagreed with this as I recall. This was so we wouldn't have any problems on it going into effect immediately in between elections, so I move adoption of the amendment, and as I say, I think as I recall there wasn't any disagreement on it even by the proponents of the bill. Is that right, Senator Hoagland and Newell? I move adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion first of all is to return the bill for the specific amendment. We are voting on the return. All those in favor of that motion to return the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is returned. Now, Senator DeCamp...okay, the motion is to adopt the amendment. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor of the motion to adopt the amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.
