SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 627. I have a series of amendments to the bill. There are E & R amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely, the E & R amendments to 627.

SENATOR WESELY: I move the E & R amendments to LB 627.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion I have is from Senator Koch. Senator Koch moves to amend the Newell amendment by adding in the case of any petition presented to any political subdivision the electors signing such petition shall be so distributed so as to include five percent of the electors of each of two-fifths of the voter precincts within a local political subdivision.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker and Mr. Clerk, there is an amendment that I had placed on the desks of....that's the one that is in the Journal?

CLERK: No, sir.

SENATOR KOCH: Oh, I will withdraw that one, Mr. Clerk. I know what that was about.

CLERK: Okay. All right, Mr. President, the next motion I have is from Senator DeCamp. Senator DeCamp moves to repeal all the provisions of LB 2 as passed by the '78 Special Session. Senator DeCamp wants to withdraw that. Mr. President, the next motion is by Senator Chambers, but I have a note that he wishes to withdraw. The next motion is by Senator Beutler. It is found on page 1462 of the Journal.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I would ask unanimous consent to withdraw that particular amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: So ordered. Have you got another amendment? Ernie? Your amendment was withdrawn, okay.

CLERK: Did Beutler withdraw his?
