SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 690A be advanced to....

CLERK: 690 what, Senator?

SENATOR WESELY: A.

CLERK: No, I have got an amendment on that one, Senator.

SENATOR WESELY: Oh, okay, fine.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, thank you. When we left the General File we were down to 872. We are now ready for...yes, okay. We are ready for LB 899. And then we are going to take up 611 and 933, and then we are through.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 899 was introduced by the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee and signed by its members. (Read title to LB 899.) The bill was read on January 23. It was referred to the Banking Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President, by the Banking Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, a couple points of clarification. If I, as committee chairman, ask to pass over the bill, what happens to the bill?

SPEAKER MARVEL: It goes to the bottom of the pile.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Bottom of what pile, General File?

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are talking...we are....just a moment. We have a passed-over file at the bottom of General File and it would go to the bottom of that.

SENATOR DeCAMP: It would go to the bottom of the passed-over file.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. Speaker, recognizing fully what I am doing, and realizing that being of right mind and what I feel to be sane, sound body, and doing what I believe to be in the best interests of Nebraska, and realizing that this issue can in no way be adequately resolved this session, structure change, this kind of thing, can in no way be resolved this session without destroying the balance of this Legislature, I respectfully ask to let
