LB 611, 933

on the committee amendments?

SENATOR WAGNER: Yes, Mr. Speaker, this bill here, 611, simplifies short extensions of lines and still guarantees other utilities in the area there wouldn't be any problem. It is a good bill. It simplifies things. It eliminates the paper work and I certainly support it. Not very often that Senator Vickers and I can vote together but we will on this occasion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 611. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. Record the vote.

CLERK: 29 nays, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Sieck, what do we do with the bill?

SENATOR SIECK: I move that we advance the bill, since the committee amendments are the bill, so I move for the advancement. And I have an amendment on there on Select File to correct some of the inequities of the Public Service Commission.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the advancement of the bill to E & R for Review. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, to advance the bill. We are not under Call, Senator.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 933.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 933 was introduced by the LR 169 Committee. (Read title to LB 933.) The bill was read on January 23. It was referred to the Urban Affairs, advanced to General File, Mr. President.
