a surplus. It is going to be added to state aid, and while all budgets next year whether it is for the university or whatever subdivision of government or whatever division of state government it is, all of them start out at nothing and we build from nothing on. We don't take what they had last year and build from there on. Therefore, I don't understand how you are going to build from the \$75 million up and not start all over again, unless it is a part of the former statutes.

SENATOR WARNER: No, Senator Keyes, it is correct to say that all budgets are zero at the beginning of the year but the collection of taxes will be based upon the level of the total appropriations that we make this year. So the money will be programmed to be collected to fund this level. Should a future session of the Legislature choose to put the \$75 million in some other purpose or a portion of it, that, of course, could always be done.

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Warner, isn't the \$55 million a part of the statutes...

SENATOR WARNER: No.

I am not saying I oppose it or I am for it. I would just like to know first of all where are the schools in my district because if I don't understand this and vote wrong, you know what is going to happen to me and every other Senator when he gets home. So if somebody could explain this to me, I would most certainly listen and be a very
