SENATOR WARNER: Senator Haberman, I will refer your question to Senator Koch. I will comment only this that perhaps I didn't make it clear that this amendment is drafted in such a way that the level of appropriation will be done with or without LB 486 being enacted, so that it can flow either way.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Maresh. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, in reply to Senator Haberman's concerns, if he looks on the handout we gave this morning, Ogallala is one of his school systems and he sees the present actuary. He looks at \$130 million based upon Senator Vicker's original amendment, estimated \$115 million, that is all dependent upon what we do here today, but if he looks there and you look at it overall, Senator Haberman, if we add this \$20 million we are talking about right now and this is actual, Ogallala would receive \$279,000 as opposed to the present \$132,000, and if you look at any of your schools, if you have the old printout based on \$130 million and you apply percentages of decrease according to how much we decrease the original aid, you will come to a pretty good understanding of what each of your school systems would receive, because if we go from \$130 million down to \$75 million, that is going to be about a forty percent decrease in the amount of aid that was originally given to you under the original printout. If you go to \$95 million, there is a lesser percent of decrease and that is a possibility as well. But if you ask some specific questions, I am sure I can go downstairs and dig out certain schools for you in your district so that you will have a pretty good idea of what you are going to receive.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Well, then the same basis of percentage would hold true for all of the schools in my district, each (interruption)?

SENATOR KOCH: That is correct.

SENATOR HABERMAN: (Inaudible) seventy-five back down to hundred and thirty...
