SENATOR KOCH: The answer is yes. Y-e-s! And I gave it to you the other day.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Okay, now this says on here, Senator Koch, it says the total mill levy replacement. It doesn't show how much money...does this show how much money the school would receive or the mill levy replacement?

SENATOR KOCH: It shows you, if you are looking at the copy I gave you a week or two ago, it shows you by lines what the old money was under the old formula. It shows you the new money. It shows you the percentage of decrease on property tax in terms of mills, if you had to raise that off your present evaluation and that is the most recent evaluation of each school system.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Does this show the new valuation where I got the tax increase?

SENATOR KOCH: Yes. It also shows you a mill levy, if you look at it.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I looked at the mill levy. Thank you, Senator Koch. I didn't ask you that question. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Venditte. The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I see ten. The question before the House is ceasing debate. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Debate has ceased. Senator Warner, do you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, first, the reason 1002 is up is that it has to be reported back engrossed before we adjourn today if it is going to be read on the 59th day and, obviously, you have to have the time to consider whatever amendments are going to be put on it in order to accomplish that. Number two, so there is no misunderstanding, those of you who would like to use additional \$20 million, should that be the figure, for some other purpose than state aid, then you want to vote no.
